



## **Additional terms**

### **Pick up goods**

The collection (and payment) of goods must take place within a period of 5 (five) working days after the purchase has taken place. (see article 10.1 of the general terms and conditions) In consultation with the auctioneer, this period can be extended to a maximum of 15 working days. If no consultation has taken place and the goods have not been collected within the specified period, the auctioneer can claim an amount of € 5 (five euros) per day per item.

### **Pictures.**

The buyers are deemed to have inspected the lots that are sold without warranty, even if the nature, condition, quantity or name does not fully correspond to the images shown. Possible deviations from the actual condition cannot give rise to the termination of the sale or to the destruction of the sale. All images are purely indicative, on the understanding that incorrect images cannot lead to the liability of Oprechte Veiling bv and/or the seller.

### **Gold, silver, and jewelry.**

We cannot guarantee the authenticity or description of colored (semi-)gemstones. Diamonds are tested for authenticity by us. The gold and silver items are tested for purity (if necessary) by WaarborgHolland bv.

### **Mechanics, timepieces, etc.**

We can in no way guarantee the correct functioning of mechanisms, clocks or electrical equipment.

### **Description and warranty when purchasing paintings:**

1. **Name with first name(s), date of birth etc.** The work is in our opinion the master's and we guarantee it. You can return the work within three weeks if it is found to be incorrect. (you submit proof that the work does not meet the description)
2. **Bears the signature of:** the work could be by the artist in question; **you have no guarantee for return.**
3. **AFTER:** the work is not by the artist in question; **you have no guarantee for return.**

**Conditions 2 and 3 therefore mean that we do not take any responsibility for the names or signatures on these works.**

### **Resale right.**

The resale right was introduced on 1 April 2006 and may apply to works of art from this auction. It applies to original works of art created by artists who are still alive at the time of sale or whose artist has died no more than 70 years before and who are nationals or residents of a country affiliated to the EU - EEA or a country that grants equal resale rights.

The Oprechte Veiling will recover the legally required resale rights fee from the buyer and will take care of the financial settlement.

The resale right fee is calculated from € 3,000 on the sales price including premium (excluding VAT) and is a graduated rate.
